

FY 2016 3rd Quarter Clean-UP Resolution to Provide Cash Flow for HCD.

WHEREAS, the Finance Division monitors the City's actual financial performance relative to its operating budget, for all funds; and

WHEREAS, in conjunction with the Finance Division each Division of City Government reviews its current revenues and expenditures and forecasts anticipated outcomes for their respective Division and /or Fund(s) ; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the grant reimbursement cycles caused by the difference in the beginning of the City and Federal fiscal years, a cash flow deficiency exists for Housing and Community Development, a Grant funded agency of the City; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the Fiscal Year 2016 General Operating Budget by providing additional cash flow resources to cover the cash flow difference in order that operations can continue without the fund having negative cash balances;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that HCD be provided \$5.0million for cash flow purposes, from The City's General Fund, to bridge the cash flow gap between the grant service provision and the reimbursement of federal funding,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Memphis that should the Federal program cease operations that the cash provided by this action will revert to the City of Memphis general fund.
