Compliance with Applicable Laws and Requirements

I understand and will abide by all applicable laws and regulations, including without limitation, the City of Memphis Food Truck Operating Ordinances and current City of Memphis Food Trucks in the Park Guidelines. I also understand and agree to adhere to the following Requirements:

Permit Requirements

- Application – Food truck/trailer operator/owner must complete application for permit.
- Each truck/trailer operator/owner must complete an application.
- Each application must include a permit fee in the amount of \$100.
- Must include contact information of owner/operator.
- Must include copy of valid food truck/trailer operating certificate issued by the Shelby County Health Department.

- Each truck/trailer operator/owner must present proof of current auto insurance and liability insurance as per the attached requirements of the City of Memphis Risk Management Department.
- Each truck/trailer operator/owner must present current Tennessee driver's license.
- Permits are valid for a six month period.
- Permit must be visibly displayed in front passenger-side of windshield of truck.
- All Food Trucks must follow the City's Food Truck Operating Ordinance.

Location and Hours

- Food Trucks may operate during regular park hours in the following parks managed by the City of Memphis:

- Based on some special events, there may be locations and dates blocked out for Food Trucks.
- Food Trucks may operate in City parks managed by a conservancy or other entity under terms and conditions established by that managing entity.

Revocation of Permit

A permit may be revoked for, but not limited to, the following reasons:

- Falsified information on application
- Failure to properly display permit
- Leaving park without cleaning up, or causing damages to the park

- Violating applicable laws and regulations, including without limitation, Operating Certificate and Health Department Food Truck Regulations, revocation of driver's license or expired insurance

RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY

I hereby waive, release, discharge, and agree to hold harmless the City of Memphis, its officers, agents and employees from any and all liability, claims, demands, rights or causes of action, present or future, whether known or unknown, anticipated or not anticipated, which may occur as the result of my participation in the Memphis Food Truck Program to the fullest extent permitted by law, even under circumstances in which such personal injury, illness, death, property damage or loss is caused in whole or in part by the action, inaction, or negligence of the City of Memphis. I expressly and voluntarily assume all risks of injury, illness, death and property damage or loss that may result from my participation in the program and operation of a food truck.

I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT I HAVE READ THE TERMS INCLUDED HEREIN AND FULLY UNDERSTAND THE TERMS HEREOF. I AM FULLY AWARE THAT THIS DOCUMENT WILL HAVE THE EFFECT OF RELEASING THE CITY OF MEMPHIS, ITS OFFICERS, AGENTS, AND EMPLOYEES FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITY OR CLAIMS OF ANY NATURE OR KIND WHICH MAY OCCUR AS A RESULT OF MY PARTICIPATION IN THE CITY OF MEMPHIS FOOD TRUCK PROGRAM.
