Request for Applications

The City of Memphis is soliciting applications for participation in the Memphis Green Communities Program to be funded through Qualified Energy Conservation Bonds (QECBs). The Memphis Green Communities Program (MGCP) will provide grant and/or loan funds to commercial property owners for energy conservation retrofits. The program is intended to contribute to an overall reduction in greenhouse gas emissions in the City of Memphis and reduce operating expenses for local businesses.

Eligible property owners may apply for funds through the MGCP to demonstrate energy savings across a single building, multiple buildings, or isolated building systems for components such as heating, ventilation, and air conditioning systems (HVAC); hot water systems; lighting; building envelope; or electricity plug load, Water-saving and storm-water mitigation technologies, and renewable energy technology. Applicants must provide an estimate of the reduction in energy consumption certified by a Tennessee professional engineer.

Applications will be available beginning September 19, 2014. The deadline for applications is October 17, 2014 at 3:00 P.M.
