

Overall a 14% reduction in false alarms was achieved from 2009 to 2010 as a result of amendments.



Information:

This chart indicates the average number of new permit acquisitions via the new website and downloads. Prior to new amendment some alarm operators went without initial registration until a signal was emitted. Companies are now required to submit monthly sales/installation data enabling timely alarm registration. Since establishing requirements, an average 318 new registrants paid for permits in July and August. This procedure provides an immediate conveniency in registering alarms aside from mail, web and visits. The process of requiring alarm companies to submit lists for new sales/installations is in its infancy. Presently disclaimer agreements from 5 national companies are being routed through legal for execution. Once disclaimer agreements are satisfied, installation lists from those and other companies will be sent. Monthly administering of these measures will perhaps vastly increase security alarm system registration.
